When the winter ski season comes to an end in May, it's time for the spring-summer period, as an infinite landscape offers itself up to skiers, mountain bikers, runners, hikers and families.

At Les 2 Alpes, there's something for everyone, depending on the season, altitude, ability and preferences. Our resort is an instant hit, at any time of year! With 70,000 visitors in summer (280,000 in winter), it attracts professionals (athletes, skiers, mountain bikers) and families alike.

Sports enthusiasts enjoy a real training ground, while families can explore a multitude of activities: walks, authentic villages (Venosc, Mont de Lans), lakes, mountain biking, hiking, trampolining, summer tobogganing, via ferrata, mini-golf, archery, family long-distance hikes, gourmet walks, starry nights and much more. Les 2 Alpes is a lively destination all summer long, with events such as the Red Bull X-Alps, the Mountain of Hell, the Urban DH, the Défi de la Muzelle and the French DHI Championships.

It's also a place where people meet and share: aperitifs on the terraces, open-air festivals and exchanges with travellers from all over the world come together to create a unique atmosphere. Top athletes such as runners Mathieu Blanchard and Yannick Noël and mountain bikers Adrien Loron and Isabeau Courdurier have set up their base here, attracted by the quality of life and dynamic sporting environment. For them, the mountains are their daily life and an exceptional playground.

No break at Les 2 Alpes: here, we make the most of the mountains in all seasons. From 5 May, it's time for a new period, a new offering and a mountain of discoveries.



or the past two years, Les 2 Alpes has enjoyed an uninterrupted season in May and June, as it continues to open up its high-altitude ski area. Over the last two years, the programme has focused more on professionals, offering national and international teams, ski clubs and ski schools a real training camp during this crucial period when few ski resorts in the world are open. This year, the destination goes one step further with a fantastic package for the public hoping to enjoy the great outdoors and mountain activities during the long weekends offered by the month of May. A real destination for a 4-day weekend getaway!

Today, Les 2 Alpes is pulling out all the stops, with a ski area ranging from 3,400 m to 2,600 m – more than enough to satisfy ski enthusiasts – and a quality snowpark for freestylers. There's plenty for pedestrians to do too, from soaring over the peaks to admiring the viewpoints (particularly from the Belvédère des Écrins footbridge at 3,400 m), taking a sledge or summer toboggan ride, strolling through the village of Venosc and along the banks of the Vénéon, chilling out on the high-altitude sun terraces or in the resort, and why not try a downhill mountain-bike ride or even a tandem paragliding flight! A timeless moment of disconnection to get back to your roots and feel good!

Also, thanks to the new Jandri cable car, a real innovation for the Les 2 Alpes destination, the summits are now accessible all year round (in less than 20 minutes). Recently inaugurated, this project – the largest of the last ten years in the French Alps – will enable Les 2 Alpes to adapt to the weather, the seasons and the expectations of its visitors, guaranteeing that it will be open from the end of November to the end of August.

Les 2 Alpes is more than just a ski resort: it's an ideal mountain destination for a wide range of activities, from holidays to weekend getaways. Designed to be accessible to all (skiers, pedestrians, mountain bikers, trail runners and persons with reduced mobility), the new Jandri features cabins with wide doors and areas adapted for wheelchairs, guaranteeing an inclusive experience for all visitors.

SKI, PEDESTRIAN AND MOUNTAIN-BIKE OPENINGS FROM 5 MAY 2025

Ski



Winter skiing ends on 4 May

From 5 to 28 May: Access to the high-altitude ski area from 3,400 m to 2,600 m.

From 29 May to 6 July: Access to the high-altitude ski area from 3,600 m to 3,200 m as well as the Signal sector (2,800 m).

From 5 May to 6 July: opening of the snowpark at 3,400 m.

Pedestrians



Week-ends: Access at 3,400 m (From May 8 to 11, 17 to 18, 24 to 25, May 29 to June 1, and June 7 to 9.).

Weekdays: Access possible at 3,200 m.

Open lifts:

- The Venosc cable car will be open at weekends.
- The Diable Télémixte hybrid lift will be open at weekends from 29 May to 1 June and from 7 to 9 June.
- From 14 June to 31 August: all lifts reserved for pedestrians.

Bike Park



Weekends in May (8 to 11, 17 and 18, 24 and 25 May): 3,200 m to 900 m via the Jandri cable car and Venosc gondola lift/mountain-bike trail on snow- Pistes: Highway to Heaven (3,200 m and 2,600 m) + Bike Patroller blue trail + Venosc red trail and Black Garden elite trail.

Weekends in June (29 May to 1 June, 7 to 9 June): the same lifts and trails as above + the Diable Télémixte hybrid lift for access to the trails: Diable, 666, L'Ange, Lilith, Styx and Les Deux Shralpes.

From 14 June to 31 August: all ski lifts and dedicated mountain-bike trails.

1. AN ADVENTURE COMBINING EXPLORATION & ACTIVITIES

In summer, Les 2 Alpes becomes an ideal destination for nature and adventure lovers. The destination offers a multitude of discoveries, events and outdoor activities. With breathtaking panoramas, alpine lakes and the purest fresh air, this is an adventure accessible to all: young and old. At an altitude of 3,400 m, breathtaking views of the peaks can be explored and quickly accessed thanks to ultra-modern lifts such as the Jandri cable car. Just a few hours from the big cities, Les 2 Alpes is the perfect choice for an active, refreshing holiday – even beyond the winter season!



An open-air play area

uch more than just a ski resort, Les 2 Alpes becomes a vast playground during the summer. Here, you'll discover countless opportunities for activities and entertainment. The adventure begins with the must-do mountain activities: hikes, walks, mountain lakes, mountain biking, climbing, via ferrata, paragliding and rafting. There are activities for all ages: summer tobogganing, mini-golf, trampolining, tennis, skatepark, pump track, snowtubing, archery, inflatable games and swimming pool. Multisports court and a padel court are also available free of charge.

The Tourist Office also offers a wide range of events, many of them free and supervised: open-air yoga, sports tournaments, picnic concerts, gourmet walks, starry nights and open-air cinema. The resort has been awarded the 'Famille Plus' label and provides specially adapted facilities for children aged 6 months to 15 years. The 'Funs Stages', supervised by professionals, offer sporting and cultural activities such as mountain biking, trampolining, rafting, climbing or canyoning, on a daily or weekly basis.

Easily accessible peaks

t Les 2 Alpes, adventure can mean taking to the heights and exploring the peaks. It's a fantastic experience, and couldn't be easier to do. All you have to do is hop on the new Jandri cable car, which takes less than 20 minutes to reach an altitude of 3,200m. You can even go a little higher and reach 3,400 m via the funicular railway. Up there, 360° panoramas reveal breathtaking views of the surrounding massifs, not forgetting the Belvédère des Écrins and the orientation table.

The new Jandri cable car, a real technological feat, makes these spectacular landscapes accessible to everyone – guaranteeing an unforgettable experience, whether you're a high-mountain enthusiast or just a visitor looking for a change of scenery.

Mountains and fresh air: the ideal adventure

n summer, the mountains become a veritable haven of freshness in Les 2 Alpes and the surrounding area. At Venosc, accessible by cable car, the white waters of the Vénéon offer activities such as rafting, hydrospeed and canoeing for guaranteed thrills. Lake Chambon, in the Romanche valley, invites you to swim, paddle and relax with a bucolic lunch at the Cabane au Bord du Lac, under the arbours. Hikers can discover high-altitude lakes such as Lauvitel and La Muzelle, while Lake Buissonnière, at the entrance to Les 2 Alpes, is perfect for a peaceful swim. Hidden away in the countryside, waterfalls are also essential places to cool off. Just 30 minutes from Venosc, the Muzelle waterfall is a must-see, while the Lanchâtra waterfall, nestled at dizzying heights, and the Cuculet waterfall, near Mont de Lans, offer a refreshing experience in the heart of nature.

My very first mountain adventures!

At Les 2 Alpes, you can enjoy your **first mountaineering experience** with a **glacier hike** accessible from age 10, at 3,600 m above sea level on the Les 2 Alpes high-altitude ski area, accompanied by a mountain guide. An unforgettable adventure in the heart of breathtaking scenery!



Do it again!

Just a stone's throw from Les 2 Alpes, on one of its peaks, you can spend a **night in a bivouac at 2,100 m** – accessible in just a few minutes, on foot, by mountain bike or by ski lift. A campfire, mountain dinner, storytelling and brunch at the summit guarantee an unforgettable experience. The La Troïka organises this night of camping once a week (equipment provided).



My very first summit, reaching 3,400 m: it's accessible and it's beautiful! Thanks to the new JANDRI cable car, you can reach altitudes of over 3,000 m in less than 30 minutes. This accessible option offers spectacular panoramic views. From 3,400 m, the 360° panoramic view of the mountains is magnificent, complemented by an ice cave and a suspended footbridge offering a view of the Écrins.





Taking my first steps climbing with the Les Lutins via ferrata! Accessible from the age of 8, this route is a cross between hiking and climbing, supervised by a guide, to immerse everyone in a breathtaking setting. Perfect for families, it offers thrills in complete safety and transforms young and old into true mountaineering adventurers. An unforgettable experience that's not to be missed!

The 'Raid des Familles' long-distance hike in Les 2 Alpes! 7 km of fun challenges in the heart of nature, with orienteering, a mountain quiz and an escape game. Laughter and a feeling of togetherness guaranteed every step of the way, with memories to last a lifetime! As a bonus, medals will be awarded to both young and old adventurers. Don't miss out on a great day of fun and sharing!

2. À-LA-CARTE ADVENTURE: WALKS OR HIKES?

he vast network of trails offers something for everyone, from easy strolls to more demanding hikes, with or without the ski lifts. With lifts open all year round, access to the peaks is easy and comfortable – thanks to the new Jandri cable car, the renovated funicular railway and the Vallée Blanche and Diable Télémixte hybrid lifts.

Our resort is an ideal base from which to explore the mountain pastures, the Vénéon and Romanche valleys and the Col du Ferrand, with over 200 km of trails, waterfalls, lakes and spectacular views at the gateway to the Écrins National Park. For a more relaxed way to explore the region, hikers can enlist the help of the mountain guides' office.

As well as rejuvenating the mind, the mountains strengthen the body by stimulating the production of red blood cells. This is one of the secrets of the athletes who come here to improve their performance.

Accessible and contemplative walks

Destination 3400

The high-altitude walk begins at the foot of the new Jandri and, just 30 minutes later, you'll find yourself with your feet in the snow at 3,400 m, immersed in a majestic mountain world. The walk takes 2 to 3 hours, with just a 30-minute walk from the funicular exit at 3,400 m to the footbridge over the void: the Belvédère des Écrins.

Panoramic walk

An easy 3 km loop, reached via the Diable Télémixte hybrid lift. At 2,400 m, there are several possible options. A short 40-minute loop, accessible to all the family, leads you to the first orientation table, with the resort always in view. The second loop takes you a step further with an aerial, contemplative experience overlooking the Aiguille de Venosc, La Muzelle and the Écrins National Park. This can take between 1.5 and 2.5 hours, depending on your photo, snack and contemplation breaks.

Family outing

There's a sector that lends itself to all sorts of discoveries, and it couldn't be easier to get to it from the resort (1.5 hours depending on breaks). The whole family can hop on the Vallée Blanche Télémixte hybrid lift to reach a height of 2,100 m and enjoy a short 2 km walk on the flat summit. The view is panoramic, with Les 2 Alpes and the resort below on one side, and the Romanche valley with Lake Chambon, Auris en Oisans and the Col de Sarenne on the other.





Themed walks

ere, walks can be fun and full of discoveries. The Explorers' Walk, designed for families, lets you discover the resort and its environment through a question-and-answer game about mountain flora and fauna. Walking is also about getting close to nature and enjoying it. Mountain guides offer the botanic and gourmet walk, a real discovery of edible or medicinal mountain plants (yellow gentian, nettle, plantain, polypody, earthnut, wild cumin, St John's wort, hogweed, musk chervil, wood sorrel and more). To get even closer to nature, the chamois-observation walk allows you to get up close and personal with the famous mountain gazelle and the Slate Walk, situated in the village of Venosc, offers a whole slice of the history of this resort and its villages. Venosc was a slate-mining village until 1972. A little anecdote: some of the roofs of the Château de Versailles feature Venosc slate.

Long-distance hiking

phe long-distance hikes from Les 2 Alpes allow you to explore incredible trails and scenery between the Vénéon valley to the south and the Romanche valley to the north. On the Vénéon side, beyond Venosc and Saint Christophe en Oisans, you'll find: Alpe du Pin, La Lavey, Le Châtelleret, Le Soreiller, le Carrelet, La Mariande and more These offer varying levels of technicality, and can be completed in a day or more (bivouac and shelter version) with the comfort of superb, intoxicating nature and the warm welcome of the guardians at the shelters of the same name. On the Romanche side, you'll find just as many walks (Les Clots shelter, Fontaine Pétrifiante, Plateau d'Emparis, Lakes Noir and Lérié, Besse en Oisans, Clavans, Lake Quirlies, etc.) from the Ferrand valley above Lake Chambon, with views of La Sure, La Grande Sure, Roche Mantel, the great peak of La Meije, the Les 2 Alpes ski area and Le Râteau. All these hikes can be found on the GR54 route, offering a tour of Les Écrins.

Two 'committed' hiking events

Friday 6 June: Rubbish-collection day

Every year, the resort joins in with a major clean-up of the mountains, as part of the Zero-Waste Mountain operation and the 'Flocon Vert' label, in partnership with the Mountain Riders. Organised by the town of Les 2 Alpes, the SATA 2 Alpes company and the Tourist Office, the aim of the day is to keep the area clean (rubbish collection, sorting and treatment) and to raise public awareness. Locals, holidaymakers and owners are invited to take part in this eco-responsible walk.

Monday 11 August: Dinner hike ... 'En rando, garde le sourire'

For six years, the 'Garde le sourire, on est là!' association has been supporting sick children and their families. It has created an event to raise funds: the dinner walk. This 11 km route, accessible to all, starts from Chalet Mounier and passes through some magnificent scenery (Diable, Lake Buissonnière, Vallée Blanche) before finishing on Rue des Vikings. It's an opportunity to discover Les 2 Alpes and savour local produce, while supporting families and research.



3. A land of sporting EXCELLENT



1. A TRAINING CAMP FOR SKI & SNOWBOARD PROS

es 2 Alpes offers a unique post-winter skiing experience, thanks to one of Europe's largest ski areas, open until early July. Culminating at 3,600 m, the ski area opens from 5 May to 6 July, depending on snow conditions. Since the 1970s, the resort has continued the tradition of spring/summer skiing, welcoming ski and snowboard athletes from all over the world in search of training facilities for future competitions. The resort chooses to keep the top of the ski area open after the winter season, as this allows it to offer a high-quality training area. But the real novelty lies in the spring skiing offer, rather than summer skiing.

HIGH-QUALITY training GROUND!

By adjusting its seasons, Les 2 Alpes adapts to climate challenges while guaranteeing optimum ski conditions between May and early July. The high-altitude area then rests and continues to be maintained until the following winter!

From 5 May, athletes, ski clubs and professional ski and snowboard teams will meet at Les 2 Alpes. Every ski and snowboard champion has trained at least once in their career on the Les 2 Alpes glacier ... Three champions per square metre, up to 100 slalom stadiums and an internationally renowned snowpark. The latest champions to come to Les Deux Alpes: Alexis Pinturault, Adrien Théaux, Tessa Worley, Taina Barioz, Nastasia Noens and more, alongside athletes from Italy, Spain, the Czech Republic, Poland, Canada, China and Korea. Freestylers can also enjoy their own dedicated area (since 1993): the snowpark.

A real 'place to be' for amateurs and professionals from all over the world, including locals: Léa Casta, Aïdan Chollet and Maja-Li Iafrate Danielsson, Snowboard Cross World Cup athletes.

2. A LAND OF MOUNTAIN BIKING

A pioneer in mountain biking and a woldclass bike park

es 2 Alpes has become a Mecca for mountain biking thanks to the Choucas Bikers, pioneers of the club founded in 1998. They created the first mountain-bike school and the iconic Mountain of Hell race, which will celebrate its 25th edition in 2025. They have naturally contributed to the diversification of the mountain offering. Since then, all Les 2 Alpes entities – ski lifts, Tourist Office, mountain-bike schools and clubs – have been working together to develop the activity and its community.

Major brands are also joining the destination, with Commencal, Bluegrass and Hutchinson, while the destination is surrounded by pros who have become Les 2 Alpes mountain-bike ambassadors – Adrien Loron, Isabeau Courdurier and, more recently, Hugo Frixtalon (Commencal team rider). Today, the Les 2 Alpes Bike Park continues to move upmarket. It has become a mountain-bike base camp for the whole of France and beyond.

The Bike Park at Les 2 Alpes, renowned for its vertical profile, offers a playground of more 100 km of trails. It attracts DH enthusiasts in summer, as well as skiers in winter. Thanks to the ski lifts, mountain bikers can enjoy access to trails adapted to their level (green, blue, red, black) and sport (downhill, enduro, cross-country, freestyle or freeride).



In 2025, riders will be able to get back to the high peaks, gain altitude, link up vertical drops and ride on snow again at 3,200 m. Experts will be free to explore the Bike Park, hurtling down tracks such as the legendary Venosc trail (red), the new elite Black Garden trail or the routes of the emblematic Mountain of Hell competition. Beginners are supervised by qualified instructors (Gravity Bike, MCF Bike Infinity, Chez Bob, etc.) to learn the basics of mountain biking, prevent falls and have fun. As with skiing, it's important to learn to mountain bike with an instructor. These beginners will start on the Easy Park handling zones and in the Vallée Blanche beginners' workshop, before progressing to green trails and then more technical runs.



Key dates for mountain biking

12 April to 4 May: Mountain biking begins in winter.

Weekends in May and June: 8 to 11, 17 and 18, 24 and 25 May/31 May and 1 June, 7 and 8 June 2025.

14 June - 31 August: Continuous opening of the Bike Park.

Who works at the bike park?

he run architects are made up of 8 bike patrols and 4 shapers. The shapers design and build the modules, while the bike patrols monitor the trails to ensure the safety and quality of courses. Since 2023, the team has been boosted by professionals from the field – Adrien Loron, Isabeau Courdurier and Hugo Frixtalon – to improve technical aspects and the site's development. Stéphane Charrel, Bike Park manager, stresses the importance of this expertise: « Developing a professional team allows us to offer a higher-end service and enrich the experience of our riders. We are constantly working on the trails to offer a world-leading Bike Park »

Les 2 Alpes moutain-bike ambassadors have chosen their base camp!

Adrien LORON is a mountain-bike pro-rider known the world over. Drawing on his expertise as a pro rider, his experience of Bike Parks around the world and his sensitivity to riders of all abilities, he quite naturally became the official mountain-bike ambassador for Les 2 Alpes in 2022. Based in Les Deux Alpes all summer long, he works alongside the bike patrols to develop and improve the Les 2 Alpes Bike Park. This summer, on 26 and 27 July, he will bring together some thirty professionals from all over the world at Les 2 Alpes for a major event: URBAN DH Les 2 Alpes 1800 District. This 'urban' version of mountain biking is a climbing mountain-bike discipline that guarantees a real show. Spectators will have the chance to watch some of the biggest names in urban mountain biking.





Isabeau COURDURIER is a great enduro World Champion (2019, 2022, 2023 and 2024). Her track record is matched only by her kind spirit. As a regular at competitions in Les 2 Alpes, such as the legendary Mountain of Hell, it was only natural that she would get involved with the resort. 'I discovered an atmosphere and a spirit that I'd never found anywhere else'. Isabeau identified with the values promoted by the resort, so much so that in 2022 she became the new mountain-bike ambassador for Les 2 Alpes alongside Adrien Loron. Like Adrien Loron, she offers an event coordinated with the resort: Girls Shredding Days on 12 and 13 July. With this event dedicated to girls, she is keen to share her passion.

Mountain-biking news

- Mountain biking on snow: discover the iconic 'Highway to Heaven' trail between 3,200m and 2,600m. Conditions permitting, it may be open right up to the Mountain of Hell weekend (20–22 June).
- The blue 'Jandri' trail has been renamed **'La 3200'**. Now, riders will make their return to the peaks! In 2025, we'll be taking to the heights again, climbing from 3,200m. The trail was completely reworked last autumn, making it more fun and easier to access. It is made up of new modules such as tables, banked turns and rollers (a succession of large bumps like whoops in skiing).
- The beginner's workshop in the Vallée Blanche sector has been extended. Mountain-bike schools will have more space to work on teaching and riding techniques.
- The mountain-bike cleaning systems co-developed with Zellteck perform well each year, considerably reducing water consumption. This is a concept for cleaning mountain bikes (using water or forced air) that is gentler on the equipment and the environment. There are four wash points in Les 2 Alpes, including two with this system unique among French Bike Parks. A new wash point featuring this system can be found at the foot of the new Jandri.
- **Hugo FRIXTALON,** aka Frix, is a rider in the Commencal team, a partner of Les 2 Alpes. He joins the Les 2 Alpes mountain-bike ambassadors and will also form part of the team of experts at the Les 2 Alpes Bike Park.





Electric moutain biking in les 2 Alpes

n and around Les 2 Alpes, this discipline is practised in dedicated areas: the Vallée Blanche sector and the Venosc sector (along the Vénéon). With an electric mountain bike, you can ride up and down hills without breaking a sweat. This is a different way of discovering the mountains, their nature and their panoramas – and above all, you don't need to be a great athlete.

Electric mountain-biking tour: imagine a 3- or 4-day stay with departure and return to Les 2 Alpes from its highaltitude area, descending to the valleys of Romanche and Ferrand via the Emparis plateau opposite the high peaks of Les 2 Alpes at 3,600 m and the mythical La Meije with their natural and majestic snow-capped peaks, and, above all passing through and staying in the three great destinations of the Oisans: Alpe d'Huez, La Grave and Les 2 Alpes.

They start young and we call them micro-riders!

arents can count on the mountain-bike schools in Les 2 Alpes to look after their little ones, handing over these little champions, eager to follow in the footsteps of the greats and top-level athletes such as Adrien Loron and Isabeau Courdurier (mountain-bike ambassadors for Les 2 Alpes), to our mountain-bike instructors in total confidence. From the age of 6, children can learn downhill mountain biking and pass their 'biker' – the equivalent of 'Étoiles' lessons in skiing. Learning begins in the Easy Park area at the bottom of the slopes, where children



learn how to handle and ride their mountain bikes. Then, they can ride on the green trails of the Vallée Blanche sector.

Local youngsters are coached at Les 2 Alpes. Two local mountain-bike clubs watch over our future champions:

- -Club VTT des 2 Alpes affiliated with the FFC, it offers training to the youngest riders, from 5 years upwards, in the various mountain-bike disciplines: enduro, DH, Freeride, Crosscountry, etc. The team is made up of 18 youngsters who perform every summer.
- -Club des Mini Choucas (under and over 6 years old) offered by the Chez Bob mountain-bike school: Mountain biking lessons for children living in the area to improve their skills by working on balance and coordination exercises.

🏲 rail running is available all year round in and around Les 2 Alpes or the surrounding area, in the heart of the Oisans. The ski lifts, some of which are open virtually all year round, including the new JANDRI and the Diable and Vallée Blanche Télémixte hybrid lifts, make it easier for runners to get up and back down the mountain after their ascent. The Les 2 Alpes resort offers an exceptional playground for trail runners, with its varied terrain, breathtaking views, mountain lakes and waterfalls. Whether you're a beginner or an experienced runner, you'll make progress while enjoying the magnificent scenery, particularly that of the Écrins National



The routes from Les 2 Alpes are almost limitless:

Rocky sections, forests, meadows, dirt tracks or technical sections.

Trail running first took root in Les 2 Alpes in 1999, with the Maratour des Glaciers. Since then, other iconic events have followed, including the Raid Light Trail, the Défi Vertical and the Défi de l'Oisans.

From then on, the discipline quickly gained in popularity, prompting the resort to structure its courses according to a colour system (green, blue, red, black) similar to that used in skiing. The Les 2 Alpes Trail association, founded in 2021 by trail enthusiasts Lucas and Laurent Sabot, has played a key role in the development of trail running in Les 2 Alpes. This association is committed to promoting the sport by marking out routes, organising events and bringing together a community of over 200 members.

Trail running has enabled me to transform my life into an ongoing adventure, where I find the freedom, joy and serenity I'd never felt before'. He has made Les 2 Alpes his new base camp.

Yannick Noël is originally from the island of Réunion. At Les 2 Alpes, he discovered ideal setting for his passion for trail running. Arriving in 2019, he quickly settled into the resort, attracted by its dynamism and environment. This ambitious runner aims to rank among the world's best in Ultra Trail, while promoting this still emerging sport. One of the flagships of the destination is **Le P'tit Polyte**, the highest Michelin-starred restaurant in Isère. Orchestrated by the talented chef Guillaume Barengo, this establishment in the heart of the Chalet Mounier hotel offers refined cuisine that has been held a Michelin star since 1999. A place where excellence meets a warm atmosphere: a symbol of Alpine know-how.

Breeding ground for innovation

Cosy international ambience






